What is Clarkston Online?

- Clarkston Online means that your child will be working 100% online from home. Students will be working on a curriculum provided by the Clarkston School District. This curriculum will teach and assess students while working from home.

Who is the teacher?

- The Clarkston School District will assign a teacher to oversee your child's progress and be a point of contact within the district.

What is the commitment I am making by signing up my child?

- For students in grades 9-12, Clarkston Online is a semester-long commitment and your child may not move between online and face-to-face learning.
- For students in grades K-8, Clarkston Online is intended to be a semester-long commitment. If needs change and you wish your child to return to face-to-face learning, your building principal will consider this request on a case-by-case basis.

How do I sign my child up for Clarkston Online?

- If you filled out the survey indicating you were wanting your child to participate in Clarkston Online, you will be contacted by your building to sign the Clarkston Online enrollment form.
- If you did not take the survey, or indicate interest, please contact the school your child attends and they will get you enrolled in the program.

When does Clarkston Online start?

- Since we need to adjust staffing and get students enrolled in the system, Clarkston Online will begin after Labor Day.
